

Agreement 2007 Queen Candidates

As a Queen Candidate of the 2007 Charlotte Frontier Days Pageant, I _____, understand that this is a wonderful opportunity to show my support for my community. As a result, I agree to:

1. Be courteous, respectful and friendly to the other candidates and those working on the Frontier Days Committee.
2. Be responsible to select my outfits for the pageant, including western wear, evening gown and opening number (outfit to be decided by director). The outfits should be conservative and in good taste.
3. Be on time to all functions required of me up to, and including the time of the pageant.
4. Attend all dance rehearsals.
5. Work with other candidates on the Queen and Court parade float.
6. Arrive on time to ride on the float in the parade, regardless of whether I am elected Queen.
7. Arrive at specified destination for group photo shoot.
8. Assist in decorating for pageant.
9. Submit my completed application form, biography and ensure that sponsorship is paid on or before August 19, 2007.

If elected Queen, agree to:

10. Participate in the following activities during the Frontier Days Festival:
 - a. Make appearances at the Saloon on Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings.

- b. Make an appearance at the rodeo on Friday and Saturday evening, as well as Sunday afternoon.
 - c. Attend the Arts and Crafts show.
 - d. Ride on the float, along with my court, during the parade.
 - e. Make appearances in the Saloon and in Oak Park on Saturday afternoon.
 - f. Attend the fireworks on Sunday evening.
11. Dress in an appropriate fashion while wearing my sash and representing Charlotte Frontier Days (western wear, evening gown, business attire, etc.) Western attire is the theme of the festival.
12. Attend all meetings of the Frontier Days Board of Directors. All meetings are held during the fourth Wednesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. in the basement of Charlotte City Hall.
13. Attend ribbon cuttings, volunteer for community activities, etc.
14. Attend ten parades throughout the State of Michigan to represent the City of Charlotte and Charlotte Frontier Days. There is an expense account to be utilized for out of town activities, must provide receipts to be reimbursed.
15. If under 21, if found to be under the influence or drinking, I will surrender my title to the first runner-up.
16. Contact the Pageant Director in the event that I am unable to fulfill my responsibilities as Queen.
