Chili Cook-Off Rules

1. Chili Cook-Off will take place at the fair grounds in Charlotte on the south side of the 4-H building.
2. Set up time will begin at 9 a.m.
3. Each team will get a 12x12 spot in which to set up.
4. Each team must provide at least a 10x10 or 12x12 pop up canopy for their spot (health department rules; all food must be prepared and cooked under a cover).
5. Each team must cook a minimum of 3 gallons of chili. You are welcome to cook more if you like. Charlotte Frontier Days will be selling cups and bowls for the public to taste the different chili's.
6. Chili turn in time will be approximately 1:30 p.m.
7. Judging will begin at 1:45 p.m. (Charlotte Frontier Days will provide the 1/2 gallon containers for the chili judging.)
8. Prizes will be awarded based on the best tasting chili. There will be prizes for 1st thru 5th place. Prizes will be presented about 3:30 p.m.
9. Contestants will be allowed to start tear down of their spot once the chili has been picked up for judging.
10. All contestants must abide by this set of rules and the rules of the Eaton County Health Department. A copy is attached to this application.
11. You will need to provide your own source of cooking apparatus. Some suggestions are a turkey fryer, Coleman Stove, or by electric. We will have a limited amount of electricity available.
