Be tasteful in selection of attire for the pageant categories (business, gown and western)

Be on time to ALL functions required of your attendance

Assist in helping with the parade float for the court and candidates

If chosen to be on court the parade is mandatory to participate (candidates are optional if schedule conflict occurs)

Will NOT be absent for individual and group photo shoot

Attend the Prince & Princess Pageant as a volunteer and introduction as a Queen candidate

Dress in appropriate fashion with sash while representing the court during Frontier Days or other functions

Court will make appearances throughout the festival in western wear

- a) the Saloon Friday and Saturday to sell cow bingo tickets*
- b) each opening at the rodeo for introduction*
- c) assist children's activities during the day*
- d) attend any other events requested by committee*
- e) if selected as Queen a guest judge for karaoke contest*

As Queen attend ALL monthly meetings of the Frontier Days Committee at the City Hall

If under 21 and discovered under influence during the festival or any other event you will surrender your title to the 1st runner-up

*Absolutely **NO** drinking while sash and/or crown is being worn*
