### Qualifications

This requires attendance and participation at a minimum of 5 festival parades. Also requires that you attend and participate in 5 local events held in Charlotte such as Relay for Life and Celebrate Charlotte. There is to be a newspaper article during your reign to update our community on your activities. Candidates are required to participate in ALL pre-pageant events and rehearsals. Rehearsals are not open to the public. Candidates must submit a signed agreement form and a completed biography with application.
