All contracts will be finalized and approved by Doretta Malerba, Charlotte Frontier Days no later than June 1st, 2008. If your contract is not approved, you will be notified by mail and your money refunded at that time.

All NSF Checks will be subject to an additional fee of \$40.00.

Set-up is Thursday, September 4th. Basic Electrical hook-up is included. Anything above this can be paid on a time and material basis with our on site electrician, Jack Parrish. All trailers, for liability reasons, must be hooked up by our electrician. All vendors will be issued a trash container. It is your responsibility to keep your area picked up and looking clean. Trash dumpsters are provided beside the rear bathrooms, your trash can be dumped there. See me for additional trash bags. Charlotte Frontier Days reserves the right to change or alter these rules at any time.

The cost for the event is **\$475.00**. Electricity and water is supplied if needed. We will provide a basic hook-up; anything above this basic hook-up will be between you and our on site Electrician, Jack Parrish. All trailers must be hooked up by Mr. Parrish for liability reasons. All electrical cords and water lines must be protected so that customers can not trip over them. All trailers must be set-up ready to go Thursday September 4th before 6pm.
