Flea Market – Exhibitor - Antique & Collectable Show  
Rules & Regulations  
2008

The 2008 Frontier Days Flea Market will be held at the Eaton County Fairgrounds, **rain or shine** (with **no** refunds for rain). In order to make the event enjoyable for the exhibitors and the spectators alike, the following rules will be **strictly enforced**. These rules have evolved from cooperation with the City of Charlotte Police Department, Department of public works, and the Charlotte Fire Department. Violators will result in expulsion from the show without refund, and refusal of future Festivals.

**Show dates & times:**

Friday, Sept. 5, 2008	12:00 Noon to Dark (rodeo starts @ 8pm)
Saturday, Sept. 6, 2008	9:00 am to Dark (rodeo starts @ 8pm)
Sunday, Sept. 7, 2008	9:00 am to 6:00 PM (rodeo starts @ 6pm)

**Check in & Setup:**

Check in Thursday, Sept. 4th, 2008 10:00 AM – 6:00 PM. Enter the fairgrounds and look for the Registration trailer located on the North east corner of the grandstands. If you are unable to check in on Thursday, you must contact me at 517-204-2569(cell) and leave me a message. Anyone we have not heard from by 5:00 PM Thursday will risk losing his or her space **without refund**, unless prearranged.

**Cost:**

Under Grandstand \$80.00 per space (12x12) **VERY LIMITED (includes Elec.)**

Inside Kardel Hall \$80.00 per space (12x12) **(includes Elec.)**

Outside Spaces:

20 x 30 \$112.50 **VERY LIMITED**

20 x 20 \$75.00

12 x 12 \$60.00

Camping Fee: \$20.00 per night. **Not all spaces can be camped on.** Smaller spaces will require you to camp in the campground, located at the rear of the Fairgrounds. Electricity Fee: **\$20.00 For Non Campers. Electricity is very limited!** If electricity is needed, we need to be informed, as this may make a difference as where to place you. Please bring lots of extension cords. **EXT. CORDS IN WALKWAYS MUST HAVE RUGS OVER THEM !!!!!!!**

**Tables & Chairs:**

In the past we have loaned tables and chairs out but we have come up on the short end and had to pay for missing items. Please bring tables and chairs needed for your set-up.

## Security:

The Frontier Days committee will in **no way** be responsible for vendor's wares or equipment. I spend the night Thursday evening at the registration trailer & there will be a non-uniformed security guards Friday and Saturday nights, September 6th & 7th **while** the saloon is letting out for the evening.

## Sales Tax License:

The vendor is responsible to pay Michigan Sales Tax through a Michigan Sales Tax License or a temporary slip available from the Flea Market Chairperson.

## Type of Exhibitors:

This is a family festival and **we reserve the right to restrict the selling of any items** we believe is not suitable for our event.

- Traditional Flea Market items are permitted.
- Counterfeits or merchandise known as knock offs, such as shirts, sunglasses, ECT..... **Will not be permitted.**
- Vendors **will not be permitted** to sell any of the following items: cowboy hats, scarf slides, bolo ties, feather bands, bandannas, or anything *stating Charlotte Frontier Days or it's Logos.*
- **No** concession type food, or beverages can be sold by Flea Market vendors.
- Bake goods, spices, and produce **will be permitted if I know in advance about it.**
- ***SPECIAL NOTE: Frontier Days Flea Market committee will not responsible for the placement (spaces) of vendors with duplicate merchandise. We will try to space vendors apart if we know they are selling the same merchandise. This sometimes is impossible, as some vendors do not list all of the merchandise they are going to sell on the application.***

## Housekeeping:

It is **YOUR** responsibility to keep your area clean. **Smokers, please keep your butts picked up!** At the end of the festival, your area must be clean and litter free. Your areas will be checked and all waste including boxes, papers, ect. **MUST BE DISPOSED OF IN DUMPSTERS BEHIND KARDEL HALL or their will be a roll off beside the bathrooms,** ( not in trash boxes or barrels) these are for customers. You will not be able to return for the next year's festival if this is not followed. **This will be enforced!!!**

## Pre-Registration for the following year Festival:

Your **advanced** application (available at check in of the current year Festival), filled out and returned. If you are a **return vendor**, in order to **ensure your same space**, you will need to return your application filled out completely, **with a check by February 29<sup>th</sup>, 2008.** You may also return the application and fee at any time during the Festival. **Places will not be held until your payment is received. Spots are filled on a first come, first serve basis.** A Confirmation will be sent out when we receive your application and your check. Once you receive your confirmation that ensures you that you have a space for the

following year. Be sure to Mail me a self addressed envelop or if you have email, just provide me with that.

**New vendors** will need to completely fill out application once received, and return it and a check made out to “**Charlotte Frontier Days**” to Doretta Malerba. 621 Pleasant St . 48813. Confirmation will be sent out upon receipt of the application and fee paid in full. **Refunds will not be given after July 1, 2008.**

**Parking:**

Upon arrival on Thursday, September 4th, 2008, at registration trailer. Parking for Vendors and Guests is provided Free of charge in the Baseball Field to the East of the Grandstands. To get to this parking lot, enter off Cochran at 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and continue south into the parking lot.

**Check Out:**

Once again, at the end of the Festival, your area must be clean and litter free. All Vendors must be off the grounds by 10:30 PM Sunday September 7th, 2008. If this is a problem, please contact the Flea Market Chairperson.

**Directions:**

From the **North** bring I-69 south to the second Charlotte exit, M-50. Turn right on M-50 or Shepard Street and turn left at the first light, Cochran. The fairgrounds will be on the left.

From the **South** bring I-69 north to the first Charlotte Exit, Cochran Road and turn left. The fairgrounds will be on the right about 2 miles down.
